Screening Determination Notice under Regulation 11

Under Regulation 9(1) of the Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004, Runnymede Borough Council has made a determination that the Climate Change Action Plan is unlikely to have significant environmental effects.

On 1 December 2023, Runnymede Borough Council determined after consultation with Natural England, the Environment Agency and Historic England that the Climate Change Action Plan is not likely to have significant environmental effects and, therefore, a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) is not required.
