

NOTICE OF ELECTION



PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION FOR RUNNYMEDE AND WEYBRIDGE

1. An Election is to be held of One Member of Parliament for Runnymede and Weybridge.
2. Forms of nomination for the Parliamentary Election may be obtained at Civic Centre, Station Road, Addlestone, Surrey, KT15 2AH from the (Acting Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered by appointment only to the (Acting) Returning Officer, Civic Centre, Station Road, Addlestone, Surrey, KT15 2AH on any day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 7th June 2024.
4. The required deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft or, with the (Acting) Returning Officer's consent.
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
6. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Station Road, Addlestone, Surrey, KT15 2AH by 5 pm on Wednesday, 19th June 2024.
7. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate>
8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Station Road, Addlestone, Surrey, KT15 2AH by 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Station Road, Addlestone, Surrey, KT15 2AH by 5 pm on Thursday, 4th July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024
