Statement of Inspection Procedure

The Energy & Climate Change Mitigation Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) provides guidance for new development in Runnymede borough on how to meet and evidence the climate change mitigation planning policy requirements in the adopted 2030 Local Plan.

Runnymede Borough Council formally adopted the SPD on **25 September 2024**, with an implementation date of **3 October 2024**.
